

Conditions of Entry Kurrawa Park Sunday Ticket 2024

In consideration of attending this event, you agree to follow the reasonable guidelines set forth by the Organiser for the duration of the event, including but not limited to:

- You must have a valid ticket or other authorisation/accreditation to enter the event;
- Each ticket is only valid for the admission of one person;
- Patrons must be 18 years of age or over and will be required to present valid photo ID
 as proof of age upon entry to event security.
 - Valid forms of identification include
 - 18+ Passports,
 - Photo Driver Licence
 - Proof of Age card
 - International Passports
 - Digital IDs
 - International Photo Drivers Licence
 - o Invalid forms of identification include anything that isn't listed above such as:
 - Photo identification that has been tampered with
 - Photo identification that is expired
 - Photos of identification documents
- Any person gaining unauthorised access to this event may be liable to prosecution;
- Any person found not to be wearing an official event wristband or official event accreditation will be removed from the event;
- Organisers reserve the right to have all persons, bags and belongings searched at the time of entry to the event. Failure to comply will mean you will be prevented from entering the event;
- The organiser reserves the right to deny admission to the holder of any ticket that appears to have been tampered with, counterfeited, or duplicated. Forging a ticket to an event will result in immediate removal from the event. The organiser may involve the police regarding the falsification of tickets to events.
- Your ticket will be exchanged for a wristband that you must keep on for the duration of the event. Lost, damaged or stolen wristbands will not be replaced. Anyone found at an event without a wristband may be removed from the event at the organiser's discretion.
- This event is licensed. Alcohol sales are subject to Responsible Service of Alcohol and Harm Minimisation Practices.
- We are prohibited by law from serving liquor to those who are deemed intoxicated;
- Activities such as 'stage diving', 'moshing', 'climbing', 'crowd surfing' and sitting on other attendee's shoulders are strictly prohibited;
- Persons causing a disturbance or refusing to comply with requests from Security will be removed from the event;
- The organiser reserves the right to refuse entry or reject patrons from the event at its sole discretion;
- By entering the event site, you agree to null and void any claim for loss, injury, or damages sustained entering or at the event;



- By entering this event site, you agree to be filmed or photographed which may be used for marketing or promotional purposes;
- The organiser reserves the right to vary advertised programmes and to add, withdraw or substitute artists where necessary;
- Volume levels at all outdoor events vary depending on many factors such as EPA noise restrictions and may or may not be as loud as an indoor event. Those choosing to enter the event do so at their own discretion;
- Smoking (cigerettes and e-cigarettes) is only permitted in designated smoking areas;
- Any person bearing offensive patches or insignias will not be permitted entry to the event;
- Anyone found to be breaking conditions of entry inside or outside the event or any behaviour deemed to be anti-social will be refused entry and/or removed from the site without refund;
- By using our medical facilities, you consent to the organiser having access to your medical records.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

The following restricted or prohibited items are not permitted by patrons into the event:

- Glass bottles or cans including perfume and makeup;
- Alcoholic beverages, e-cigarette liquids, and foreign liquids;
- Open drinks (only sealed non-alcoholic drinks and empty reusable water bottles are allowed into the event);
- Illicit drugs;
- Steel Cap Boots;
- No steel-framed folding chairs, deck chairs, or reclining chairs will be permitted into the
 event. Basic canvas camping chairs with a back no higher than 100cm will be permitted.
 At a certain time, those wanting to still use a chair will be directed to relocate to a
 designated seating area;
- Knives or other dangerous weapons including potential missiles;
- Flares, fireworks, or sparklers;
- Lasers or laser pointers;
- Animals or pets other than guide dogs and companion pets (paperwork must be provided);
- Professional recording or broadcast devices without the organisers permission;
- Drones or other airborne recording/photography devices;
- Flags with poles, large flags, or banners (over 60cm long) that may obstruct the view of other patrons;
- Any item that you intend (or such quantities of the item from which Management can reasonably infer that you intend) to distribute, hawk, sell, offer, expose for sale, or display for marketing or promotional purposes;
- Large items including hard eskies, hard drink coolers, or ice boxes;
- Umbrellas;
- Any other items as determined by Security or Management that may be deemed as dangerous goods, cause injury or public nuisance;



 Any prohibited items found will be confiscated. Alcohol will be disposed of, illegal substances or weapons or items considered dangerous, or offensive will be handed over to the police.

PRESCRIPTION MEDICINE

Medication is allowed to be brought into the event, under the following conditions:

- It must be in its original packaging and untampered. This must be placed in a clear, resealable bag accompanied by the proof of script and requirement.
- All medication will undergo normal security processes upon entry. At the discretion of the Front Gate Manager / Security Manager.
- You may be required to present medication to the Event Medical Team before entering the event.
- Medication may be required to be held at the Event Medical Operations Unit until the attendee who possesses the medication exits the event.
